

# BEFORE TRAVELLING

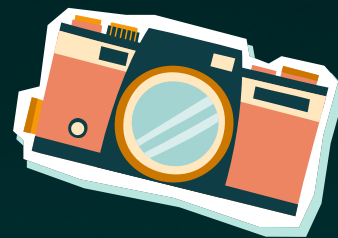


SPAIN IS A VERY SAFE COUNTRY, BUT IT IS ADVISABLE TO TAKE CERTAIN PRECAUTIONS BEFORE STARTING YOUR TRIP.

- 1 Beware of **holiday rental scams**. Be wary of bargains and don't send personal documents or payment without being 100% sure.
- 2 If you need a **taxi** when leaving stations or airports, use **official taxi ranks** to avoid unlicensed taxis.
- 3 Be careful of **insecure Wi-Fi**. Open networks are an open door to your device.
- 4 Use a secure **means of payment** and avoid transferring money in advance.



# RESPONSIBLE TOURISM



- 1 The Assistance Services for Foreign Tourists (**SATE**) helps travellers from other countries deal with police formalities.
- 2 Everyone in Spain, including foreign tourists, must **have ID documentation** (identity card or passport), in case it is required from them. (pasaporte), por si le es requerida.
- 3 For alcohol consumption in public places, please refer to town regulations.
- 4 Comply with the laws and regulations wherever you go and remember that **ignorance of the law is no excuse for breaking it**.

## PRACTICAL TIPS

- 1** Keep an eye on your belongings, especially in crowded places.
- 2** Do not accept offers or assistance from anyone acting suspiciously.
- 3** When going out or sightseeing, take **only what is absolutely necessary**.
- 4** Know in advance the daily itinerary you plan to follow to avoid unforeseen events.
- 5** Respect local environment and behave accordingly.
